The yacht must return to its base no later than 17:00 on the day before the charter ends to complete the check-out procedures.

***For charters in April, October, and November, the yacht must return by 16:00 at the latest.**



How to reach Paros island:

Paros is easily accessible by daily ferry and high-speed boat services from the ports of Piraeus and Rafina, as well as from the other islands of the Cyclades. The island also has an international airport, with daily flights from Athens International Airport.

Our base is located just 20 km from Parikia Port and 16 km from Paros Airport.

By public bus:

There is a daily public bus service connecting Parikia with Piso Livadi. For more information, please visit the official bus service website: <https://ktelparou.gr/en/index.html>

By taxi:

Taxis are readily available at the airport, and the journey to Piso Livadi takes approximately 15 minutes.

Transfers (upon request):

Athenian Yachts can arrange transfers by minibus (up to 17 passengers) or taxi. Please request your transfer at least 7 days before your arrival.

Provisions Service:

There are two mini markets located around Piso Livadi Bay, approximately 100 metres from our boats. A larger supermarket is also available in Marpissa Village, just 1 km from our base. Provisions can also be arranged by the Athenian Yachts Team upon request at least 5 days before your arrival. Your order will be delivered onboard before your arrival. Payment is accepted in cash only.

Market opening hours:

Mini markets: Monday–Sunday 09:00–21:00.

Supermarkets: Monday–Saturday 09:00–21:00. Sunday closed.

Bank Transactions:

All pre-ordered extra service payments can be made by credit card (Visa/Mastercard) or cash. Banks are only available in Parikia, and they all have ATMs.

Fuel/Electricity:

Upon delivery, the boat's fuel tanks must be full. The pier in Piso Livadi Bay has a limited number of pillars with electrical outlets.

Check-in Procedures:

The Skipper and Co-Skipper must attend the check-in procedure, which includes port police formalities, documentation procedure, yacht technical demonstration, and inventory inspection.

Port Police Formalities & Documentation Procedure:

At the beginning of the check-in, you will be required to sign the charter documents (charter contract and crew list form) and complete any pending payments (extra services, security deposit, or damage waiver).

Early Embarkation:

The standard embarkation time is 17:00. The boat will be clean and ready for your arrival. Early embarkation can be requested at least 5 days in advance and is available at an additional cost.

Late Arrival:

Our base staff is available at the base until 21:00. In case of a flight delay, the boat will be open and the keys will be left on the chart table. Check-in will be completed the following morning at approximately 09:00. For any assistance, our base manager is available by mobile phone.

Check-out Procedures:

The boat must return to its base no later than 18:00 on the day before the charter ends. Please inform the Base Manager of your expected arrival time in advance by phone or text so our staff can be prepared to assist you.

Upon arrival, our staff will assist with mooring the boat in the designated position. In case of any issues during your trip, please inform our staff.

During check-out, our staff will inspect the boat and its equipment to ensure it is in perfect condition, with all inventory present and ready for the next charter. The boat will also undergo an underwater inspection by a diver.

Departure is at 09:00 the following morning. Please avoid delays, as our staff needs sufficient time to prepare the boat for the next guests.

Before departure, please return all items to their original places. Kitchen items should be washed, dried, and stored away. Place dirty linen on the floor and leave clean linen on the beds. Remove all rubbish and dispose of it in the port bins. Life jackets and blankets should be left on the beds.
