The yacht must return to its base no later than 18:00 on the day before the charter ends to complete the check-out procedures.

***For charters in April, October, and November, the yacht must return by 17:00 at the latest.**



How to reach Skopelos island:

The island of Skopelos can be reached by ferry or speedboat from Agios Konstantinos Port or Volos. The nearest international airport is Alexandros Papadiamantis Airport on the island of Skiathos, located approximately 8 nautical miles from our base. There is a daily ferry connection from Skiathos Port to Agnontas and Loutraki Port on Skopelos. From Agnontas Port, Neo Klima Harbour is approximately 16 km away, while the distance from Loutraki Port is approximately 10 km.

By sea taxi:

Sea taxis are available at Skiathos Port and take approximately 30 minutes to reach Neo Klima Harbour.

Transfers (upon request):

Athenian Yachts can arrange your transfer by sea taxi from Skiathos or by taxi or minivan from any port in Skopelos. Transfer requests should be made at least 7 days prior to your arrival. Prices are available upon request.

Provisions Service:

There are several minimarkets, a bakery, and grocery shops in the area. Provisions can also be arranged by the Athenian Yachts Team upon request at least 5 days before your arrival. Your order will be delivered onboard before your arrival. Payment is accepted in cash only. If you are arriving on a Sunday, our base staff will be happy to assist you with shopping for provisions at our corporate supermarket.

Market opening hours: Monday–Saturday 08:30–21:00. Sunday closed.

Bank Transactions:

All pre-ordered extra service payments can be made by credit card (Visa/Mastercard) or cash. There is an ATM located approximately a 10-minute walk from the harbour.

Fuel/Electricity:

Upon delivery, the boat's fuel tanks must be full. The floating pier is equipped with 220 V electrical outlets.

Check-in Procedures:

The Skipper and Co-Skipper must attend the check-in procedure, which includes port police formalities, documentation procedure, yacht technical demonstration, and inventory inspection.

Port Police Formalities & Documentation Procedure:

At the beginning of the check-in, you will be required to sign the charter documents (charter contract and crew list form) and complete any pending payments (extra services, security deposit, or damage waiver).

Early Embarkation:

The standard embarkation time is 17:00. The boat will be clean and ready for your arrival. Early embarkation can be requested at least 5 days in advance and is available at an additional cost.

Late Arrival:

Our base staff is available at the base until 21:00. In case of a flight delay, the boat will be open and the keys will be left on the chart table. Check-in will be completed the following morning at approximately 09:00. For any assistance, our base manager is available by mobile phone.

Check-out Procedures:

The boat must return to its base no later than 18:00 on the day before the charter ends. Please inform the Base Manager of your expected arrival time in advance by phone or text so our staff can be prepared to assist you.

Upon arrival, our staff will assist with mooring the boat in the designated position. In case of any issues during your trip, please inform our staff.

During check-out, our staff will inspect the boat and its equipment to ensure it is in perfect condition, with all inventory present and ready for the next charter. The boat will also undergo an underwater inspection by a diver.

Departure is at 09:00 the following morning. Please avoid delays, as our staff needs sufficient time to prepare the boat for the next guests.

Before departure, please return all items to their original places. Kitchen items should be washed, dried, and stored away. Place dirty linen on the floor and leave clean linen on the beds. Remove all rubbish and dispose of it in the port bins. Life jackets and blankets should be left on the beds.
